Iwate University (May 1949)
[Faculty of Liberal Arts,
Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Agriculture]

Renamed the Faculty of Liberal Arts to the
Faculty of Education (April 1966)
Established the Faculty of Humanities and
Social Sciences (May 1977)

Re-established National University Corporation,
Iwate University (2004)
Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences,
Faculty of Education, Faculty of Engineering,
Faculty of Agriculture

Reorganized the Faculty of Engineering into
the Faculty of Science and Engineering (April 2016)

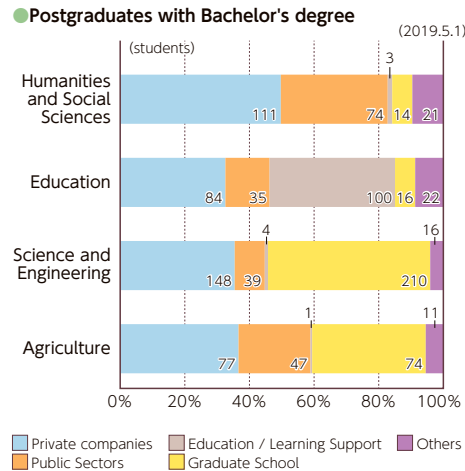

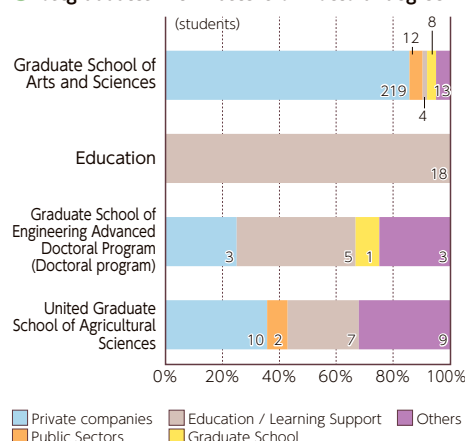
